(c)(4)(iii) Clinical ratings will be scored as follows:

Zero – If veteran completes the task without assistance.

One – If veteran can complete 75% of the task without supervision or assistance.

Two – If veteran can complete 50 to 74% of the task without assistance.

Three – If veteran can complete 25 to 49% of the task without assistance.

Four – If the veteran can complete less than 25% of the task without assistance.

71.40 cont.

(c)(4)(iv) If the sum of all the ratings is;

(A) **21 or higher** – the veteran is assumed to require **40 hours per week** of caregivers assistance.

(B) **13 to 20** – the veteran is assumed to require **25 hours per week** of assistance.

(C) **1 to 12** – the veteran is assumed to require **10 hours per week** of assistance.
